



RETURNS TO THE MARINA ON NOVEMBER 3

EXPECT ROAD CLOSURES AND TRAFFIC DELAYS BETWEEN
6:45 AM AND 10:15 AM

Dear Community Members and Visitors,

The Golden Gate Half Marathon will return to the city of San Francisco on November 3, 2019. We are contacting you in advance of the race to share information about road closures that will cause mild delays in and around the Marina. Race organizers will implement a "traffic valve" to assist in minimizing these delays. A traffic valve is a traffic control method designed to alternate traffic in opposite directions, with brief pauses, to allow traffic to continue moving and reduce the need for a full street closure. Motorists should be advised that traffic will be paused momentarily while using a traffic valve. Law enforcement will signal when it is safe to "release" the valve and allow traffic to continue safely. Traffic valves will be installed at Yacht Road and Baker Street and at Webster Road and Marina Boulevard. The San Francisco Police Department and race crew will be on site to assist motorists in and out of the area safely. For the safety of all involved, please abide by the directions of law enforcement.

Sections of Van Ness Avenue, Bay Street, Beach Street, Laguna Street, and Marina Boulevard will be impacted from 6:45am to 10:15am. Please see the related portion of the course map below for reference.
